In summary, both OGA 2022 and OGA 2023 showcased the industry's advancements and provided valuable opportunities for networking and collaboration. OGA 2023 witnessed increased international participation, highlighted by a higher number of professional and trade visitors from a wider range of countries. The Exhibition space take-up increased in line with the number of participating companies and the presence of international pavilions facilitated global partnerships. OGA 2023 also demonstrated significant business potential, emphasizing the event's importance as a platform for promoting innovation and fostering industry growth.

OGA's collaboration with local and international partners significantly contributes to industry development and the energy transition agenda

OGA is a proven platform that collaborates with local and regional industry partners as a single unified voice to drive prevalent industry agendas. As an industry platform and a prime gathering of peers, OGA and its partners create a comprehensive platform for knowledge sharing, business opportunities, and technological advancements in these industries. OGA and its esteemed partners contribute to the growth and development of the industry with a focus on embracing sustainable practices and exploring opportunities for energy transition.



In our EIC Survive and Thrive Report, we found that supply chain companies have shifted focus back to oil and gas, predominantly due to challenges in availability of consistent work and profitability in renewable energy projects. The same report also revealed that, based on Financial Investment Decision data, oil and gas projects are more likely to proceed with full funding, compared to renewable and transition technologies such as wind and hydrogen projects. These findings raise prospects of rapidly widening disparities between green ambitions and reality of what businesses see in their order books. Ultimately, raising concerns that net zero 2050 commitments are likely to be delayed.






